2025 Terms and Conditions

World Math(s) Day for 2025 will take place on 26 March 2025!

Participating in World Math(s) Day is free for students aged 5 to 18. Students can enter this event by either using an existing Mathletics login, or signing up (with the consent of their school or guardian) to a World Math(s) Day account for this event.

As a condition of entry, participating schools and students accept that the school name and the student initials for the grade/level entered may be published on our website in connection with this event and our event rules. Event rules are set out on our website including this section.

To be eligible for prizes:

- Students must compete in the current year/grade level that they are enrolled in as of the day of the competition, 26th of March 2025.
- Students can only take part in the event once, using one Mathletics/World Math(s) Day student login. If a student is found to have used multiple accounts to participate, they will not be eligible for prizes.
- Students who are not signed up via a school must show proof of age and school level (which we will request from their parent or guardian at or after the event registration) to be eligible for prizes.
- We aim to have prizes delivered to winners within 4-6 weeks after we finalise the event results for all year/grade levels.
- Students must answer all questions by themselves without assistance. May the best Mathlete win – do your best!

Event Rules

World Math(s) Day brings the students in the world of math(s) together over 48-hours.

During that event, students can log in once to challenge themselves for a place on the global leaderboard that can be viewed publicly at <https://www.3plearning.com/world-maths-day>.

The school, grade, country and the student's initials will be published during the course of the event.

The results and winners will be announced on our website after the event for all year/grade levels. The parent or school that consented to the Winner's participation will also be contacted.

Prizes referred to on our website must be accepted 'as is' by the winner, and cannot be transferred or exchanged. We reserve the right to substitute any of the prizes with a similar prize of an equal or greater value in our discretion if for reasons outside of our control either (a) the prizes are no longer available; or (b) the prize is not able to be delivered within the specified timeframe.

How to win a prize

Top 3 Student in each Global Year / Grade (Global Student Winners)

These students achieve 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in each of grade level K to 9, globally.
