

Create special coupon cards for your students, with your students!


## How do I use this pack?

When a student exhibits excellent behavior, effort or results (based on the student's individual learning outcomes), reward them with a special coupon to use in your classroom.




### My Music Pass

Listen to music while you work.




### Class Music Pass

Pick music for the class to listen to while you work.




### Snack Pass

Bring a snack to enjoy in class.




### Late Work Pass

Leave class a couple of minutes early.




### **2nd Chance**

Fix your mistakes on a test to get a better mark.




### **Movie Master**

Take a 5-minute walk around the school.




### **Dinner Theater**
