




Summer Exploration Journey



- Now select the activity (purple bars)




Try 3-5 new activities, you think you might enjoy.

How many credits do you have this week? What do you want to buy? Do you have enough credits? If not you can always earn more by completing extra activities and quests.




Complete Week 2 Maths Journal






Do you want to start with some games this week? Before you decide on what quests, activities, and challenges to do this week, try spending some time in the PLAY section of Mathletics!


