Welcome to the November Numeracy Challenge!

This competition will run from **Monday 21st to Friday 25th November**.

Each class/school will aim to complete as many Mental Minute sprints as possible within the time period.

The top schools will be those with the highest average total of sprint points. This is calculated by taking the total number of sprint points divided by the total number of registered students in the school.

Our top 5 schools will win a special prize!

How does it work?

Your students will use Mental Minute in Mathseeds to finish as many sprints as possible during the week! The top 5 schools will receive an awesome prize pack!

What is Mental Minute?

Mental Minute is a fun and engaging way for students to practice their maths facts and build up their fluency.

There are 145 unique sprints, and in each sprint, students answer as many quick-fire questions as they can in 60 seconds. Students can choose to practice either addition and subtraction or multiplication and division.



How do my students access Mental Minute?

1. Students log into their accounts.
2. Click **Mental Minute**.
3. Select addition and subtraction or multiplication and division.
4. Start answering!

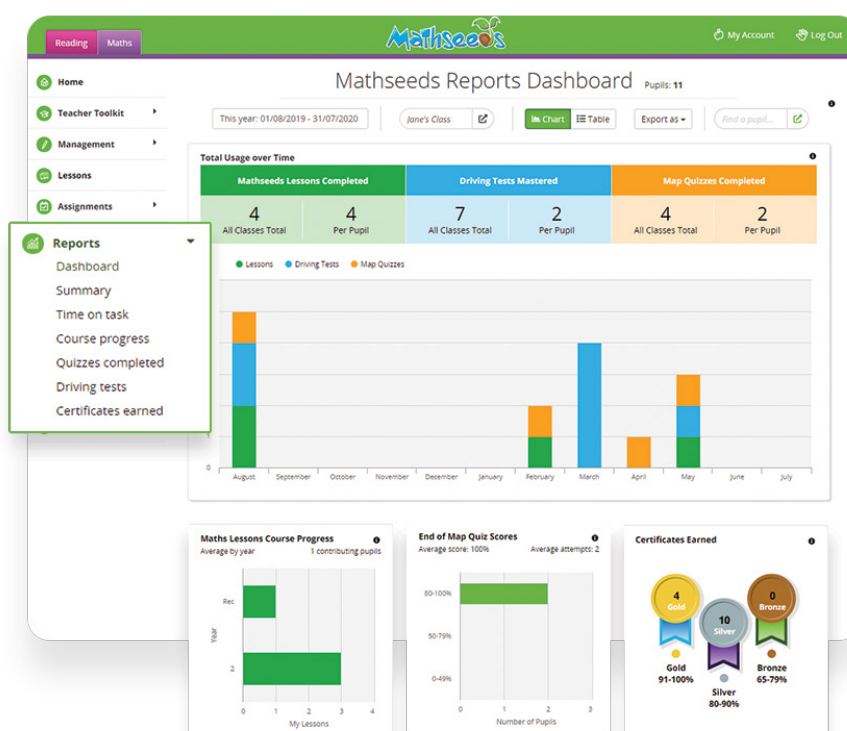
