All About Me Activity


Suitable for Grades K-2

Help students settle into the classroom and get know each other during the first few weeks of school with this activity. Each student fills out their own profile on the worksheet. They can write short answers, bullet points, include drawings, it's up to them.


Then, form pairs and give students 10-15 minutes to present their profile to their classmate.

Snowball Story Writing

Suitable for Grades 3–6



Make your students first literacy lesson of the year a ball of fun with this snowball writing activity. This collaborative and creative writing activity helps you get an understanding of your students writing ability, encourage students to build rapport with others and develop a positive and pressure-free learning environment.

Instructions:

1. Split classroom into groups of 3-5 students to discuss ideas.
2. Provide each group with 1 worksheet.
3. Fill out the beginning of the story based on the title provided at the top of the page.
4. Once complete, pass the worksheet to another group so they can fill out the middle of the story.
5. Repeat step 4 so a different group can add an ending to the story.
6. At the end, pass it to the final group to draw a picture that represents the written story.

Note: A blank template as also been included so you can add in your own story ideas.
