

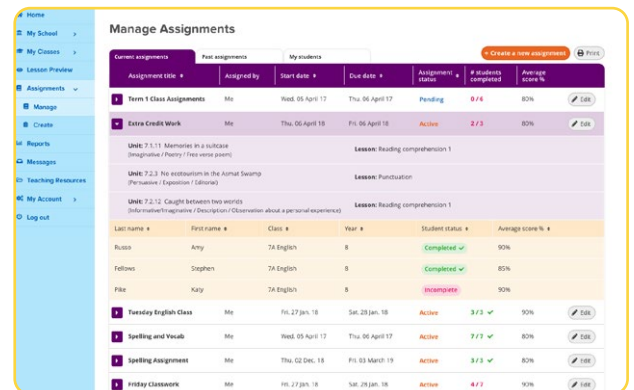
# Quick Guide to Differentiation with WordFlyers



## 1 Assign a Lesson from a WordFlyers Unit

- Go to **Assignments**
- Click + **Create a new assignment**
- Select a name, students and start and due date
- Find activities using the dropdown filters
- Add activities to assignment by clicking + **Add unit/lesson to assignment**
- Click + **Create this assignment**

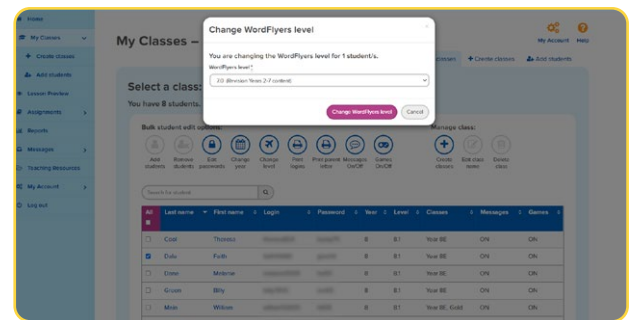
You can preview any WordFlyers Unit or Lesson before assigning it to a student by visiting your Lesson Preview tool.



## 2 Set Students' WordFlyers Levels

- Go to **My Classes**
- Select a student
- Click **Change level**
- Change level
- Click **Change WordFlyers level**

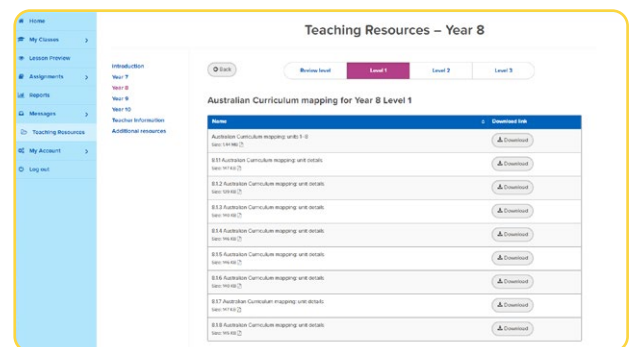
Use students' results to help you determine the appropriate WordFlyers level for them.



## 3 Use Additional Resources to Target Learning

- Go to **Teaching Resources**
- Select a **year level** for writing worksheets or **Additional resources** for various learning activities
- Choose an activity
- Click **Download**

Each year level has interactive writing PDFs that students can complete and send back for marking without having to print it off.



## 4 Use Reports to Tailor Learning Pathways

- Click **Reports**
- Select a class or individual student
- Select a specific report

- Select report date range
- Drill down to a specific WordFlyers level (optional)
