1 Points and Badges

- Students login
- View total points in the top right corner
- View badges on Learn grids or in My reports

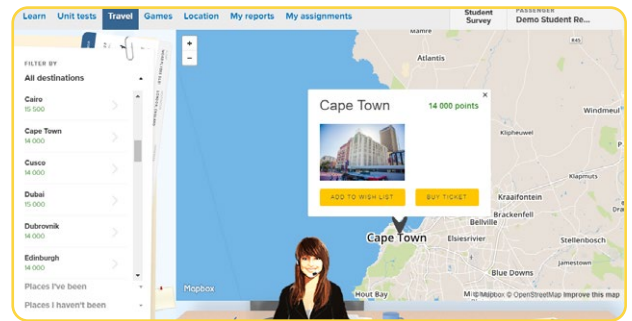
Students can also view the points they have earned for a content area by viewing their Learn grids.



2 Travelling

- Students login
- Click **Travel**
- Select a destination
- Click **Buy Ticket**

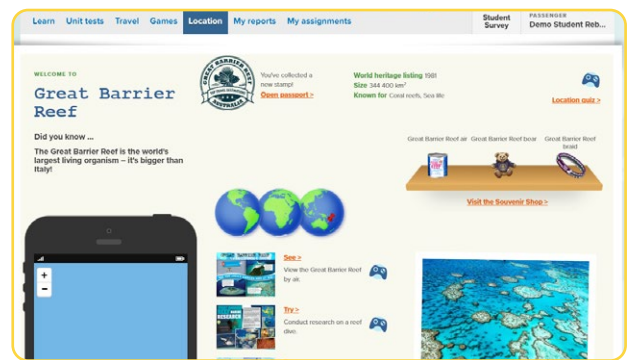
Students receive a new passport stamp for every destination they travel too and there's no shortage of destinations to explore!



3 Learning About New Destinations

- Students login
- Click **Location**
- Click **See, Try or Do** to learn more about the destination
- View slideshow to see destination images
- Click **Location quiz** to take a quick fact quiz

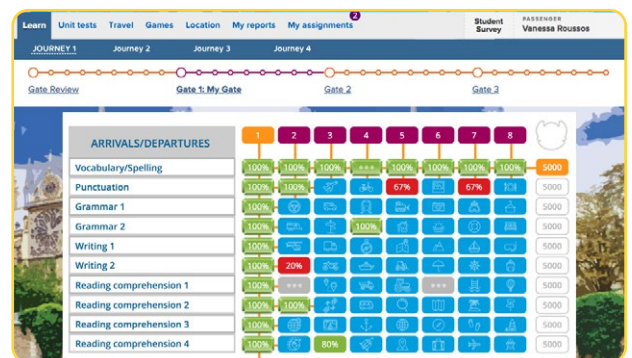
Students can learn lots of interesting facts in every location they travel to. It keeps students engaged, reinforces literacy skills and encourages them to learn historical and geographical facts.



4 Tracking Their Own Progress

- Students login
- Click **My reports**
- Click **Overview** for a snapshot of progress and badges earned
- Click **Lessons complete** to see exactly what's been completed

Allowing students to see their own results helps them stay motivated and engaged in their literacy learning. They'll keep trying so they can reach mastery!



5 Games

- Students login
- Click **Games**
- Select a game to play

Students can spend the points they earn on some fun games. Each time they want to play a game they must give up 500 points, keeping them motivated to learn and earn more points to play!
