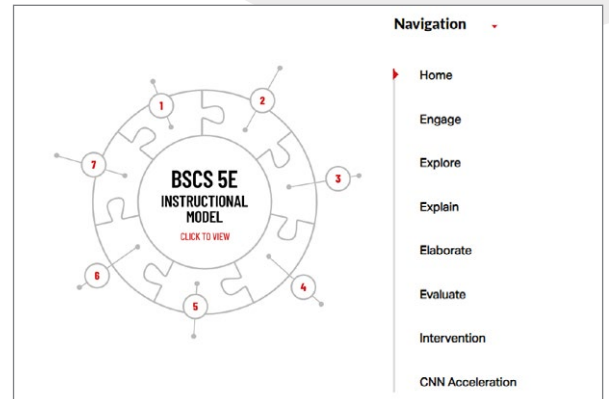


Quick Guide to Lesson Planning with STEMscopes Science

1 Use the 5E Model to Build Your Lessons

- Find the module to match your science topic
- Pick an activity from a 5E area

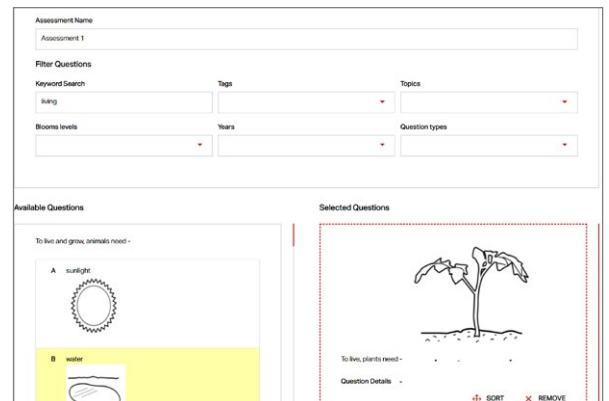
We recommend working through a module sequentially, starting with Engage, working your way down. You don't have to use all the activities and resources available, just what you need to help your students reach mastery.



2 Assign Curriculum-aligned Modules

- Click **Modules** and select a module to work on
- Use the navigation bar on the right to find a module activity
- Select **Student View**
- Click on the student icon
- Select students and start and due date
- Select **Add this Assignment**
