## 1 Flipped Classroom Model of Blended Learning

The flipped classroom model involves introducing concepts and new content online via assigned activities and then practicing them in class with teacher assistance.

- Click **Assignments**
- Click **Create Assignment**
- Select your class
- Add start and finish dates
- Select your year/grade level and then Reading, Spelling or Storylands lesson
- Click **Create the assignment**
