1 Flipped Classroom Model of Blended Learning

The flipped classroom model involves introducing concepts and new content online via assigned activities and then practicing them in class with teacher assistance.

- Click Assignments
- Click Create Assignment
- Select your class
- Add start and finish dates
- Select your year/grade level and then Reading, Spelling or Storylands lesson
- Click Create the assignment

2 Station Rotation Model of Blended Learning

The station rotation model of blended learning involves students rotating through different learning stations in class.

It is a good idea to use the tech station as a fun but educational break. In addition to completing activities with Reading Eggs, the online station could also involve Reading Eggs games as an extra motivator.

- Students login
- Click Play or Games
- Select Game
- Learn through play

3 Use digital alternatives to traditional literacy activities

- Login and select Teacher Toolkit
- Click Big Books or Book Notes
- Search for a book by category, age group and series or click **Go to the library** to explore.

Another fantastic digital alternative front-of-class activity is creating a story together using Story Factory.

- Login and select Reading Eggs
- Login as a demo student
- Click Story Factory
- Click Story Factory again on the right-hand side.
- Click Start a new story
