

Quick Guide to Differentiation with Reading Eggs



1 Assign a Driving Test

- Click **Assignment**
- Click **Create Assignment**
- Select students
- Add a start and finish date
- Select **Driving Test**
- Click **Create this assignment**

Once students have completed their Driving test, click into **Manage Assignments** to view results.

2 Create learning groups

- Click **Management**
- Click **Manage Classes**
- Enter new class name
- Click **Students** and select students you would like in your new group
- Click **Add existing students into your class**

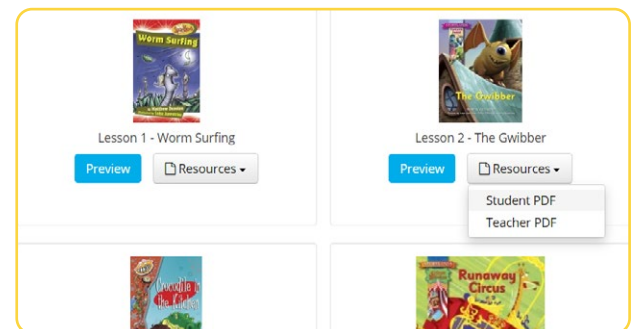
You can differentiate learning by assigning bespoke lessons to your new group (class). You can move students to another group/class as they progress.
