

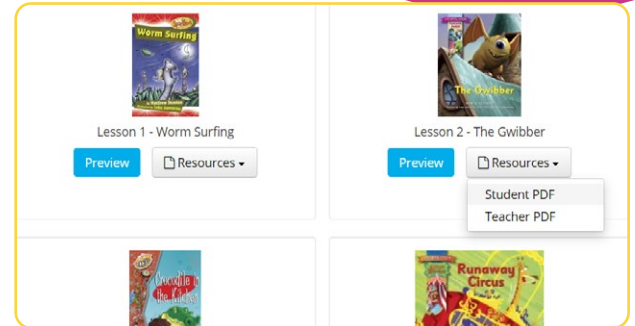
Quick Guide to Lesson Planning with Reading Eggs



1 Preview Lessons and Resources

- Go to **Lessons**
- Choose a lesson
- Click **Preview**
- Click **Resources**
- Select **Student PDF** or **Teacher PDF**

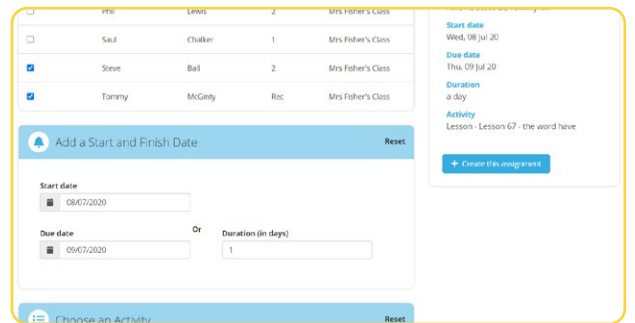
Preview will give a student view of each Lesson. Resources are the accompanying student worksheet and teacher notes to supplement the Lesson.



2 Target Individual Learning with Assignments

- Go to **Assignments**
- Click **Create Assignments**
- Select your class or individual students
- Add a start and finish date
- Select the type of activity, the year/grade level, and the specific lesson
- Click **Create this assignment**

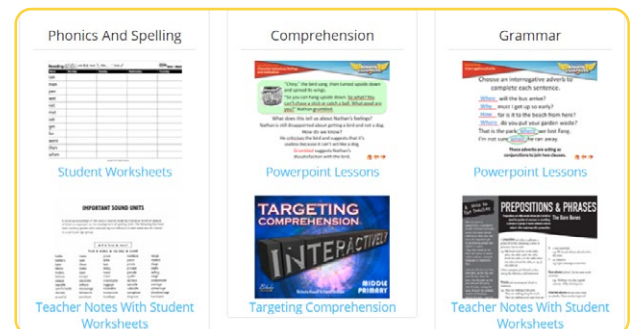
In Reading Eggs, set Reading, Spelling or Storylands lessons to all or selected students. In Reading Eggspress, set a Comprehension or Spelling lesson, or a Library Book, to all or selected students. All other areas of Reading Eggs/ Eggspress will be locked until the assignments are completed.



3 Use the Teaching Resources

- Go to **Teacher Toolkit**
- Choose from year/grade **K-2/ 3-4/ 5-6 Teaching Resources**
- Explore the resources

The teacher resources cover Phonics and Spelling; Comprehension; Grammar; Writing and Targeting English.



4 Use Big Books for a Guided Reading Session

- Go to **Teacher Toolkit**
 - Select **Big Books**
 - Choose a **Level**
 - Pick a book from the list
 - Read with your class on the IWB or equivalent
- Most Big Books have accompanying **Book Notes** with lesson planning ideas and worksheets.
