Launch Lesson: Teacher Letter



Dear educators,

Thank you for participating in the Reading Eggspress Launch Lesson! Reading Eggspress lives within the Reading Eggs platform and makes reading real books, improving spelling skills, and building comprehension fun and engaging for intermediate readers. Please note that the Library is part of the Reading Eggspress Launch Lesson. Should you be using one of our programs for emerging readers, Reading Eggs or Fast Phonics, and wish to also use the Library, please see the singular Library Launch Lesson.

The intent of this Launch Lesson is to make the transition to using Reading Eggspress in your classroom as straightforward as possible, for both you and your students. The Launch Lesson is intended to be played in front of students with their devices and login information so they can follow along and complete tasks during each of the **six pause points**. It is important to note that your students will be completing the initial **Placement Test during this Launch Lesson** and will need headphones.

The following are reminders and best practices to review prior to beginning the Launch Lesson video with your students.

- Each student will need an internet-enabled device (laptop, Chromebook, or tablet) and headphones. If your classroom/ school does not have enough devices for each student, we suggest using a station-rotation model, likely completed over several classroom periods depending on the number of available devices.
- To watch the Launch Lesson video, you will need a Smartboard, overhead projector, or large screen to ensure all students can see the demonstrator. If this is not available, we again suggest using the station-rotation model, wherein one small device would be used for the Launch Lesson video with a smaller group of students.
- Students will need to have their login cards with them. These can be accessed from your teacher console by following these steps:
 - o Log into Reading Eggs teacher account
 - o Click Management → Manage Students
 - o Use check boxes to select students
 - o Click Print logins
 - o Print and distribute login cards
- Your school may use a single sign-on program, such as Clever. Check if this is the case prior to beginning the Launch Lesson, as this will determine how students log in.
- We highly recommend that you explore both your teacher console and the student console prior to beginning the Launch Lesson with your students.
